What is Hope25?

- Hope25 is an opportunity for us to share the hope that we have in Jesus
- It is an intentional season of **sharing hope in Jesus** for every parish and community in the Anglican Church of Australia
- We are asking each parish to commit to doing (at least) one thing to help share the hope that we have in Jesus during this season
- We aren't going to tell you what to do, but we will provide resources and support so that each parish can act locally and contextually, sharing the hope we have in Jesus in a way that best fits your context

When is Hope25?

- Easter Day (April 20) to Pentecost Sunday (June 8) 2025
- However we are encouraging parishes and dioceses to start praying and planning now
- Lent 2025 will be a key time of preparation and training

What might we do in our parish in 2025?

- Run an outreach video course (there are many to choose from - see the Hope25 website)
- Host a Hope25 dinner with a testimony
- Run a guest service
- Have special events using existing ministry groups. e.g.: playgroups, op shop teams, bible study groups
- Running a church building "Open Day" event
- Plan to use Lent in 2025 for training and preparation using resources provided

It's really up to each Anglican congregation to prayerful discern something new and creative to share the hope we have in Jesus.

How do we get started in our parish?

- Form a parish Hope25 team of volunteers and clergy
- Join the Hope25 mailing list on the website to receive monthly guidance and preparation activities
- Consider joining with a neighbouring parish
- Ask your Bishop for help and find out who are your Diocesan Hope25 movement leaders.
- Start praying regularly

Hope25 is being led by the General Synod Mission and Ministry Commission.
